THE EVOLUTION OF ACADEMICIAN VLADIMIR KOPYEYCHYKOV IN THE FIELD OF HUMAN AND CIVIL RIGHTS

The twentieth century was not only a breakthrough in industry and technology, but also in creating the legal principles, a catalyst of which acts as a protection of human rights and freedoms. Namely «human». Not employee or official, not Christian or Muslim, teenager or pensioner, man or woman, citizen or refugee.

These are categories, which are derived from the concept of «personality» and separately are considered in legal, social or moral contexts. After the birth we get a number of rights that are natural, that are not assigned by someone and no one can detach them.
