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# IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ANTI-CORRUPTION PROGRAM OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS IN 2020

The anti-corruption program of the Ministry of Internal Affairs is designed for the medium term and is a logical continuation of the measures envisaged in previous anti-corruption programs of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine for 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 – programs developed in the reformed Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine. Its development took into account the results of the analysis of corruption risks in the field of the

Ministry of Internal Affairs, as well as the results of the Anti-Corruption Program of the Ministry of Internal Affairs for 2019. According to the analysis, out of 114 measures that the interested units, bodies / formations or institutions of the Ministry of Internal Affairs had to implement, 113 measures were implemented in 2019 or 99 % (98 % were implemented in 2018, 91 % in 2017), 1 were not implemented. or 1 % (in 2018 – 2 %, in 2017 - 9 %).

The purpose of the Anti-Corruption Program of the Ministry of Internal Affairs is:

- improvement of the system of prevention and counteraction of corruption in the staff of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, territorial bodies, institutions, establishments and at the enterprises belonging to the sphere of management of the Ministry of Internal Affairs;
- ensuring coordination of the system of prevention and counteraction of corruption in the National Guard of Ukraine, the National Police, the State Border Guard Service of Ukraine, the State Emergency Service of Ukraine, the State Migration Service of Ukraine;
- further implementation of mechanisms of transparency, integrity, reduction of corruption risks in the system of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and increase of the level of public confidence in the activity of law enforcement agencies.

Ways, stages of implementation and means to solve the problem

The problem of reducing corruption in the system of the Ministry of Internal Affairs is expected to be solved by combining the efforts of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, the National Guard of Ukraine, the National Police, the State Border Guard Service of Ukraine, the State Emergency Service of Ukraine, the State Migration Service of Ukraine., institutions and enterprises belonging to the sphere of management of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, and public organizations aimed at continuing the implementation of measures in the field of anti-corruption policy, which began in 2016, in the following priority areas [1]:

- 1. providing a systematic approach to preventing and combating corruption:
- Organizational measures have been taken to prevent and combat corruption (development, approval and submission for approval to the Agency of the Anti-Corruption Program of the Ministry of Internal Affairs; approval of draft anti-corruption programs of the Central Executive Bodies; the National Guard; preparation of the Anti-Corruption Program of the Ministry of Internal Affairs; belong to the sphere of management of the Ministry of Internal Affairs; conducting inspections on the organization of work to prevent and combat corruption in the subjects of the system of the Ministry of Internal Affairs.)
  - Normative legal regulation of relations was carried out.
- Ensuring the effective functioning of authorized units (persons) for the prevention and detection of corruption in the system of the Ministry of Internal Affairs.

- 2. implementation of anti-corruption policy in personnel management, formation of a negative attitude to corruption, training and measures to disseminate information on anti-corruption programs:
- The personnel management system has been improved, corruption risks in personnel decision-making have been minimized.
- Training and measures to disseminate information on anticorruption programs have been implemented.
- Conditions have been created for notifications of violations of anticorruption legislation.
- 3. implementation of measures to comply with the requirements of financial control, prevention and settlement of conflicts of interest:
- Compliance with the requirements of anti-corruption legislation in terms of financial control is ensured.
- Implementation of control measures on compliance by officials of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, heads of territorial bodies for the provision of services of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, heads of institutions, establishments and enterprises belonging to the Ministry of Internal Affairs, restrictions and requirements to prevent conflicts of interest due to enterprises or corporate rights done.
- Implementation of control measures on compliance by officials of the staff of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, territorial bodies for the provision of services of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, institutions, establishments and enterprises belonging to the Ministry of Internal Affairs with restrictions and requirements to prevent conflicts of interest in connection with joint work.
- Awareness-raising activities related to compliance with the requirements for the prevention and settlement of conflicts of interest are in the process of implementation.
- 4. prevention of corruption in the field of public procurement, strengthening the efficiency of financial and material resources management, development and support of the internal audit system:
- Monitoring of public procurement in order to minimize corruption risks is partially at the stage of implementation and fully implemented.
- Improving the efficiency of financial resources management is constantly being done.
- Ensuring transparency in the implementation of budget programs is constantly performed.
- Strengthening the efficiency of material resources management at the implementation stage.
  - The internal audit system is constantly being improved.
  - 5. improving the process of providing administrative services:
- Prevention of abuse of power and official position in order to speed up the procedure of providing services at the stage of implementation.
- 6. participation in the implementation of measures within the competence of the Ministry of Internal Affairs approved by the order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraineof October 5, 2016 № 803-r, and the Communication Strategy in the field of preventing and combating

corruption, approved by the order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukrainedated August 23, 2017 № 576:

- Participation in the implementation of the Communication Strategy in the field of preventing and combating corruption has been partially implemented.
- Participation in the implementation of measures to prevent corruption of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, developed within the framework of the Government-Public Initiative «Together against Corruption» at the stage of implementation.
- 7. cooperation with the public and international organizations on the implementation of anti-corruption measures:
- Information campaigns on the implementation of the Ministry of Internal Affairs' anti-corruption policy are constantly carried out.
- Interaction with the public regarding the implementation of anticorruption measures is feasible, but some aspects are being implemented [2].

In conclusion, while researching this topic, the website of the Ministry of Internal Affairs [3.] helped me a lot. Given the pandemic, many measures have not been taken or are still being implemented, but I am sure that this lost time will definitely be made up for.
