Moreover, a patrol police, a special unit known as KORD (Rapid Operational Response Unit), analogous to the American S.W.A.T., was introduced.

It's also worth noting that sometimes the National Academy of Internal Affairs hosts trainings with the participation of American officers. They have a lot of experience and practical and professional skills to share with our officers. It is very cool that US officers share their experience in our academy. In the future, this can help improve the skills of our officers.

In conclusion, the impact of police officer training in the USA on Ukraine's law enforcement is significant. The transfer of knowledge, methodologies, and best practices can contribute to the ongoing reform efforts in Ukraine's Ministry of Internal Affairs.
